



**Our Autumn
Term 2017**



Ourselves (4 weeks)

As part of this topic, the children will explore their 5 senses (seeing, hearing, touching, tasting, smelling). They will also be talking about their families and the environment they live in. We will also help children develop new friendships and relationships within their new class.

The F1 children will visit Spinney Hill Park to hunt for the different signs of Autumn.

The F2 children will walk around the local area, becoming more familiar with their local environment.

Nursery Rhymes (4 weeks)

As part of this topic, the children will be learning and acting out many different nursery rhymes. Counting and number skills will be developed through the different rhymes as will their reading skills.

Transport (4 weeks)

During our Transport topic, children will be learning about different vehicles. Their vocabulary will be developed as they look closely at cars, bikes and scooters. Maths skills will be developed by counting in different scenarios such as: counting wheels on bikes and lorries, completing a traffic survey.

example: when you're out

registrations, house numbers
or whilst cooking.

Try to ensure your child gets
plenty of sleep and a good
breakfast in the morning.



Help your child to practise mark
making, this can be done in a
variety of ways: with chalk,
paint or in sand, foam or mud.

and the children have their P.E. Kit
on a Monday (Class RW and MP
am), Tuesday (Class MP pm) and
Wednesday (Class LI)

Help your child to practise the
phonic sounds they are learning
this term and recognising these
in a variety of texts.

Please share and talk
about books and play
games such as I-Spy,
rhyming games and sing
nursery rhymes.

Children will take part in
daily outdoor learning
activities. Please ensure
that children are
