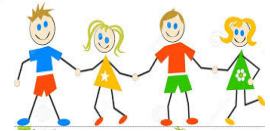


The children have all worked very hard in the Summer term and we have been really pleased with the end of year achievements in reading, writing and maths as well as the super work in all other subjects.
