Dear Parent / Carer

I am writing to ask for your support and assistance with regard to some health and safety matters.

At school we have a number of children who have allergies to nuts and should they come into contact with nuts or be near to someone with them at any time, this can lead to allergic reactions which in some cases can be very serious and possibly life threatening.

Therefore, we would like to ask that if you provide your child with a packed lunch at any time you ensure that there are no nuts included. We would also ask that you ensure that no foods brought into school contain nuts, particularly spreads such as Nutella.

We have had recent incidents where children have brought food items including nuts into school and children in their year group have a serious nut allergy. I am sure you can appreciate how serious the consequences of this could have been. Therefore, can you please ensure that your child is not bringing nuts into school at any time.

Could we also ask that no food items are sent into school at the present time when it is a child's birthday due to the current Covid 19 situation.

I would like to thank you in advance for your help in ensuring that we keep the risk of any allergic reactions and potential dangers as low as possible.
