



## Spring Update for Lower Key Stage 2

The children in Lower Key Stage 2 have made a fantastic start to the Spring term and in this update we would like to share with you some of the exciting learning and activities that we have been involved in this term and what we are looking forward to!

### What have we been learning in Spring 1?

In Spring 1 we have learned about 'Music' and how orchestras are formed. We learned the names of instruments and composed and played some music in small groups. We thought about how music is used in films.

This term we have had a fantastic time learning about 'Chocolate'! A chocolatier came to school to show us how to make chocolate and how to cook with it. We used our geography skills to find out where the cocoa beans are grown to make chocolate, then we learned why fair trade is such an important way of helping the cocoa bean growers (thanks to a Fair Trade representative). In science work we found out that materials melt, taking different amounts of time. We designed our own chocolate bars and advertised them in posters.

Our final week has focused on the topic Teeth and how to take care of our teeth.

### What are we looking forward to?

In Spring 2 we are looking forward to learning about Health and Nutrition, including planning and making some healthy meals. We shall learn about our muscles and bones and how our digestion system works.

We will be reading poems and playscripts next half term in preparation for a very special event – we are hoping that a theatre company will be coming into school towards the end of the term to help our children write, produce and perform a production entitled Evington Included, Evington Celebrated.
